Course Description:

ESL 015 is a grammar-based speaking class in an English-only environment for the advanced ESL student. Students will further develop listening comprehension and will increase fluency, accuracy and confidence in oral production.

Prerequisite:

“C” or higher ESL 014 or appropriate placement.

Objectives:

1. Demonstrate mastery in using and recognizing real and unreal conditionals, past and future progressive, present and future perfect tenses.
2. Demonstrate mastery in using, producing and recognizing gerunds and infinitive in oral and aural exercises.

Student Learning Outcomes:

1. Orally state the main idea of a listening segment of no more than five minutes.
2. Apply the pronunciation rules for (ed) endings in past forms of regular verbs in aural discrimination activities.
3. Demonstrate competency in inferring the meaning of a listening segment by identifying the speaker’s attitude or feeling or distinguishing between facts and inferences.
4. Demonstrate critical thinking skills by comparing two or three summaries of a listening segment and identifying the one that best summarizes the segment.
