Course Description:

This course is designed to help students with a disability or multiple disabilities, to understand their computer usage capabilities and to determine, through an instructor evaluation, the appropriate hardware and software. (Nontransferable, nondegree applicable).

Course Outcomes:

- 1. Instructor will assist students with determining their appropriate hardware and software needs.
- 2. Students will improve on their typing skills and basic computer skills.
- 3. Students will be able to complete assignments for classes which they are concurrently enrolled in utilizing the adaptive software.
- 4. Students will be responsible for logging into the High Tech Center to record their hours so that they can receive credit for this course. Instructor will demonstrate the process to the students and they will ask for assistance as needed. By the end of the semester, 100% of students will be logging into the lab independently or be responsible for requesting assistance from instructor or lab assistants.
