Course Description: This course is designed to fit the needs and desires of students who are interested in vocal music. Students who are interested in this ensemble would benefit from previous musical experience in any vocal or instrumental program, however, it is not required for enrollment. Basic instruction in breath control, tone placement, articulation, enunciation and listening skills are emphasized during the semester to further advance students abilities. The selected literature for this ensemble is representative of a comprehensive choral music curriculum. This course entails three major community concerts off-campus.

Required Materials: Students are required to have their music folder, music and pencil for each rehearsal. Concert attire is made available on a rental or purchase option for the semester.

Participation: Students are expected to attend all classes as well as any extra rehearsals and performances as part of their grade. They are expected to be punctual. Any unexcused absence will affect the results of the final grade.
