

**EMTP 235:** Prerequisites – successful completion of EMTP 200, EMTP 210, EMTP 215 EMTP 225, & BIOL 090. This is the field training phase of the program, enabling the student to put all didactic & skills training, as well as the clinical experience, together in the field setting. The field internship is a period of supervised experience on an emergency response vehicle which provides the student with a progression of increasing patient care responsibilities which proceeds from observation to working as a team member, then team leader. The student will be under the direct supervision & observation of an EMT-Paramedic approved by the EMS authority. After progressing through record keeping & participation in actual patient care, the student shall ultimately function as the patient care leader. In addition to scheduled field time, the student must complete 40 ALS contacts as defined in the California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9.

**EMTP 245:** Prerequisites – successful completion of EMTP 200, EMTP 210, EMTP 215 EMTP 225, EMTP 235 & BIOL 090.
