# **Course Description**

Prerequisites: The student must be able to speak and read English. Not open to students with native ability in Spanish. (See SPAN 220/Formerly SPAN 20A). For additional oral practice, concurrent enrollment in SPAN 113 (Formerly SPAN 5A) is recommended. The beginning Spanish course is based on a contrastive analysis between Spanish and English and is designed to develop in the English-speaking student rudimentary abilities in the four basic language skills: hearing, speaking, reading, and writing. The main emphasis is on the present tense of both regular and irregular verbs. The student will be familiarized with those features of Hispanic culture, which reflect the different frame of reference from which the native speaker of Spanish views the world. Additional language structures and vocabulary practice will be assigned. We will cover: Chapters Preliminary and 1 through 5 of the textbook and LingroLearning ¡Anda! and there are five chapters tests.

# Course Prerequisite(s) and/or Corequisite(s)

The student must be able to speak and read English. Not open to students with native ability in Spanish or those who have studied in a Spanish Speaking Country. (See SPAN 220) For additional oral practice concurrent enrollment in SPAN 113 is recommended.

Several written (Escrituras) tasks will be assigned throughout the course at the end of every chapter in Canvas. The instructor will assign the topics for these written tasks in class. Paying attention to the grammar (including accent marks) is important. These tasks will be assigned at the end of each chapter. Be careful; these written activities will be graded based on their content, such as style, use of vocabulary, and grammar. Escrituras are in class. **Read the instructions before starting this task**.

#### **Discussions:**

There is a discussion every week. The first discussion starts on the first week. You will find the discussion topic at the bottom of the Modules or click on the tool Forums. Click where it says discussion, you won't see anything until you post your task, read, and follow instructions for you to post your activity. There are two due dates for Discussions for each chapter. Do not forget that you will also have to comment on two of your classmates' activities. These discussions will be worth 12 points each. Your first post is due on a specific date, and it must have at least 100 words and your second post are comments on two of your classmates must have at least 50 words. Otherwise, you won't receive full credit. Also, you must type your first post for you to complete the second part of the discussion. In other words, if you do not type your first post, you will receive zero for the discussion on the specific week even though you type the comments on two of your classmates' activities.

If any student uses inappropriate language or is disrespectful to another student, that student will lose points and need to have a personal conversation with the instructor. Remember, this is a college class, and the discussion should be academic in nature, so don't get off topic or you will also lose points.
